



## User Manual MK002

Thanks for purchasing the MK002 Scissor Microphone Arm with Shock Mount. This piece is mostly assembled. Photos of the finished product that may help in your assembly can be found at [www.griffin-stands.com](http://www.griffin-stands.com). Type MK002 into the search bar. Basic assembly is as follows.

Thanks for purchasing the MK002 Scissor Microphone Arm with Shock Mount. This piece is mostly assembled. But to keep packaging as compact as possible there are two pieces you will need to add before use.

On the bottom of the arm, where the bulk of the cable comes out, you'll see a small rod approximately 1 1/2" (3.8cm) long. Slide the clamp onto this rod fully on "lock" into place using the set screw knob. You will also need to attach the microphone clamp of your choice, either the standard mic clamp for handheld mics or the shock mount for studio condenser mics. You may also need to use the adapter provided depending on the mic clip.

There are three different adjusting points. The first one is located near the microphone clip. The second is located at the middle joint and the third is the knob that holds the scissor arm to the clamp. Once the arm is clamped to a table, this third adjustment can be loosened to allow the arm to swing left or right.
